
TOWANDA PUBLIC LIBRARY

Please email: safety@villageoftowanda.org with questions or to set-up an appointment.

You will need:

- golf cart/utility vehicle (needed for inspection)
- driver's license
- current insurance info

Fees:

\$25 one-time application fee (not needed if you paid last year)

\$50 <u>yearly</u> permit fee per vehicle
